OVERVIEW

2 Days trip to Luxor from Hurghada is tailored for those who like to explore as much as they can from Luxor attractions. Also, you will explore the famous Hatshepsut temple in Deir El Bahari and witness the colorful scenes of the Punt Expedition and agriculture during Egypt day tours. Golavita Travel arranges this tour with a private guide and a private new brand vehicle to ensure the best services to all our clients.Also, you will visit the Cult temples of Karnak and Luxor dedicated to Amun, the universal god during the New Kingdom from our Hurghada day tours. You will see Obelisks, Pylons, Hypostyle Hall, Sacred Lake, Calendars, and Scarab. Besides, the massive statues of Memnon on the west bank decorate the Mortuary temple of Amenhotep III.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Hurghada - Luxor

Golavita representative will meet you at your hotel lobby to start your 2 day trip to Luxor from Hurghada. It takes around 4 hours driving with a short break on the way for coffee, toilet, and breakfast. Upon arrival to Luxor, you will start your Luxor day tours on Luxor's east bank.

Karnak temple

Start your Overnight Luxor attraction with <u>Karnak temple Complex</u> which is the biggest temple not only in Egypt but in the world. Indeed, there is a lot to see in Karnak such as Ptah temple, the Hypostyle Hall, Mut temple, Khonsu temple,

and the Barque shrine of Ramesses III. Also, you can visit the Red Chapel of Hatshepsut, the White Chapel of Senusret I, Sacred Lake, and the Festival Hall of Thutmose III. Meanwhile, wall reliefs explain a lot about Egyptian religion, ancient Egyptian history, and creation Myths. Later on, you can enjoy free time on your own to take some photos before you go for lunch.

Lunch: Enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant as part of your <u>Hurghada travel</u> <u>packages</u>.

Luxor temple

Your next stop will be <u>Luxor temple</u> which is an amazing Pharaonic temple on Luxor's east bank dedicated to God Amun Ka Mut. The entrance of the temple is decorated with six colossi statues for Ramesses the Great and an Obelisk. Also, the wall carvings show one of the most important Festivals in ancient Egypt, the Opet Festival. While, Amenhotep III started the construction Ramesses the Great, Hatshepsut, Thutmose III, Horemheb, and Alexander the Great added to the temple reliefs. At the end of your <u>Luxor attractions</u> on Luxor's east bank, your guide will help you to check in at your hotel overnight.

Day 2 Luxor - West bank

Enjoy your morning breakfast at the hotel before you start your Luxor tour on the west bank.

Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut

On Luxor west bank you will visit <u>Hatshepsut temple</u> which is located in Deir El Bahari not far from the Mortuary Temple of Mentuhotep II. Senmut, Queen's engineer built the temple for Hatshepsut in a very unique way. Indeed, there are a lot of amazing places especially the second level such as Hathor Chapel, Punt Expedition, and Anubis Chapel. Moreover, the walls reliefs show important events the Queen's Divine Birth, agriculture in ancient Egypt, trading, and Music and dance in ancient Egypt.

Valley of the Kings

Then you will explore <u>Valley of the Kings</u> on Luxor west bank was the final resting place of all the Pharaohs of the Eighteenth Dynasty, Nineteenth Dynasty, and Twentieth Dynasty. Moreover, <u>Tutankhamun's tomb</u> is very famous in the Valley of the Kings. The walls of the tombs are decorated with the Book of Day, Book of Night, Book of Heavenly Cow, Book of Caverns, and the Book of Imyduat. You can visit 3 tombs included in your ticket and you can choose from:

- (KV 02) Rameses IV
- Tomb of Ramses III (KV 11)
- Ramses IX Tomb KV 6
- Merenptah tomb (KV 8)
- The tomb of Tausert and Setnakht (KV 14)
- There are also 3 extra tombs against charge such as Tutankhamun tomb, Seti I tomb, and Ramesses V.

Lunch Meal: Enjoy your lunch in a nice restaurant behind Memnon Colossi

Memnon Colossi

Your last stop on Luxor's west bank will be <u>Memnon Colossi</u>, the massive statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III seated on the throne while his mother and wife are portrayed long his feet. The Colossi were decorating the entrance of his Mortuary temple but it is in ruins now. The temple was used for Mummification purposes or Opening of the Mouth rituals. Later on, you will drive back to your hotel in Hurghada
