1 Luxor Private Trip

05.00 am: pick-up time from your hotel.

06.00 am: start time from <u>Hurghada</u>, and checkpoint to Luxor for all the coaches going to Luxor tours from Hurghada.

07.00 am: 20-minute coffee break at a cozy lounge to use the toilet (10 L.E per person), have your breakfast, enjoy a drink then start over to Luxor with Golavita Travel Egypt.

09.30 am: Karnak temples complex, Start your Luxor trip from Hurghada with Karnak temple, the biggest temple in the world. You will guide will explain to you about ancient Egyptian civilization, and Egypt history during the New Kingdom when Luxor was the capital of Egypt. Watch the ancient Egyptian language decorating the walls and the Egyptian gods and goddesses. Meanwhile, discover how big is the Obelisk of Hatshepsut, and the columns of the Hypostyle Hall. Equally important, visit the Sacred Lake, go seven times around the great Scarab, and the Festival Hall of Thutmose III.

- 11.30 am Lunch: Enjoy your freshly cooked lunch at a local restaurant with the possibility of vegetarian meals.
- 12.15 pm: in case you like to enjoy a short <u>Nile Cruise tour</u> with a motorboat to see Luxor from the water, you can against charge. Also, you will pass the famous Winter Palace where Agatha Christy wrote 5 of her fiction stories.
- 12.50 pm: Memnon Colossi, Your first stop on Luxor's west bank will be the Colossi of Memnon once decorated the entrance of the Mortuary temple of Amenhotep III. Learn about the Myth behind the name and the mummification in ancient Egypt that took place in that temple.
- 13.15 pm: The <u>Valley of the Kings</u> is on the top of Luxor day tour attractions and one of the best things to do in Egypt. The Pharaohs of ancient Egypt during the 18th dynasty, 19th dynasty, and 20th dynasty used the place to bury their mummies. Kings Valley has 63 tombs (now more) containing the funerary objects, mummies, treasures, coffins, and papyri of the Pharaohs. Because of

this, the Pharaonic tomb robbers stole a lot of them in ancient and modern times. With your entrance ticket, you can visit 3 tombs and you can shoot photos inside for free. These three tombs could be 3 of the following tombs:

- (KV 02) Rameses IV
- Tomb of Ramses III (KV 11)
- Ramses IX Tomb KV 6
- Merenptah tomb (KV 8)
- The tomb of Tausert and Setnakht (KV 14)

After visiting your 3 tombs and shooting some photos of the astronomical ceiling of the tombs, you will be ready for your last stop.

14.45 pm: <u>Hatshepsut temple</u>, enjoy your last stop at the temple of the only female who ruled Egypt as a king for about 23 years, Queen Hatshepsut. Start your Egypt travel packages by walking the avenue of the Sphinxes in front of the temple and looking at the only two restored statues of Hatshepsut. Once, you are on the second terrace, discover Hathor Chapel, Punt Expedition, Anubis Chapel, and the Divine Birth story of the Queen. The last level of the temple shows the Osiris statues of Hatshepsut and the holy of holies inside the mountain.

The entrance is decorated with two figures of Hatshepsut with the White Crown and Red Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. At the end of your tour, it is time to start your way back to your hotel in Hurghada with a short break to toilet, drink, or stretch your legs for a while, you can also book with us Cairo tours from Hurghada and one of our amazing Luxor tours from Hurghada.
