There is a lot to see in <u>Karnak temple</u> such as the Red Chapel of Hatshepsut, Mut temple, Khonsu temple, and Ptah temple. Besides, ancient Zodiac, astrology, and sculpture in ancient Egypt. Enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant before you proceed to your next stop.

Your next stop will be the Valley of the Kings, you marvel the tomb of

<u>Tutankhamun</u> in the Valley of the Kings and the Funerary Objects they found inside it. In fact, you can visit 3 tombs included like the tomb of King Ramesses V, tomb of King Ramesses I, tomb of King Ramesses XI, tomb of King Ramesses III, and the tomb of Merenptah and Tausret.

Then you will explore Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut, Hatshepsut's engineer built a beautiful temple in Deir El Bahari close to Mentohotep II temple and Thutmose III temple. End your Luxor tour with the Memnon Colossi, massive statues for Amenhotep III decorating his Mortuary temple on the west bank of the Nile River.

At the end of your <u>Luxor tours from Hurghada</u> to the East and West banks, your guide will drive you back to your hotel in Luxor.
