

## Dendera and Abydos Trip from Marsa Alam

color and the famous Abydos King List.&nbsp; Besides, the 7 chapels are dedicated to the main gods, including Seti himself, such as Horus, Isis, Osiris, Ptah, Rahorakhty, and Amun-Re. Moreover, the Osireion and the secrets behind it. &nbsp; Golavita Travel offers these Marsa Alam tours, including Qena and Sohag attractions. All these phenomenal places will introduce you to ancient Egyptian Civilization and ancient Egyptian history.

## ITINERARY

### 1 Tour Details

Start your Dendera and Abydos from [Marsa Alam](#) when you meet your guide in the lobby of your hotel. You will start your Marsa Alam tours with one of the most beautiful Greco-Roman temples in Egypt.

#### Dendera temple

The present temple was built by Ptolemy IX Soter II for the goddess Hathor but it is believed that the original temple dates back to Cheops. Also, Pepi I Meryre's name was found in one of the Dendera Crypts, and Thutmose III from the New Kingdom was added to that temple. The oldest part of Dendera temple now dates back to Nectanebo II from the 30th Dynasty, the Mammisi.

Dendera Temple is very famous as the cult center of Hathor and there are a lot to see such as Roman Birth Houses, or Mammisi, Christian Basilica, Fourteen crypts, and goddess Nut chamber.

Besides, The Isis temple, Sacred Lake, ancient Egyptian Calendar, Sanatorium, and Osiris room. Actually, Dendera was connected to the [Edfu temple](#) during the beautiful feast of the reunion between Hathor and Horus of Edfu. At the end of your tour to Hathor temple, you will proceed with your guide to your next stop.

### Abydos temple

After visiting one of the healing centers in ancient Egypt, you will visit another unique temple in Sohag, the Abydos temple. Actually, Abydos is very famous as a burial place for the kings of the 1st and 2nd Dynasties of ancient Egypt and it was a pilgrimage place during Egyptian history.

Abydos Temple is famous for the 7 holy shrines of Isis, Horus, Ra-Horakhty, Osiris, Amun-Ra, Ptah, and Seti I. Also, the Abydos Kings List, Abydos Helicopter, and very colorful carvings cover the walls of the temple. Pharaoh Seti started the temple, his son Ramesses II finished it and his nephew Merenptah added parts there.

While you are in Abydos, you will see the Osireion from outside and the temple of Ramesses II with the chance to add Shunet El Zebib against the charge. At the end of your Marsa Alam excursions to Abydos, you will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before you head back to your hotel in Marsa Alam.

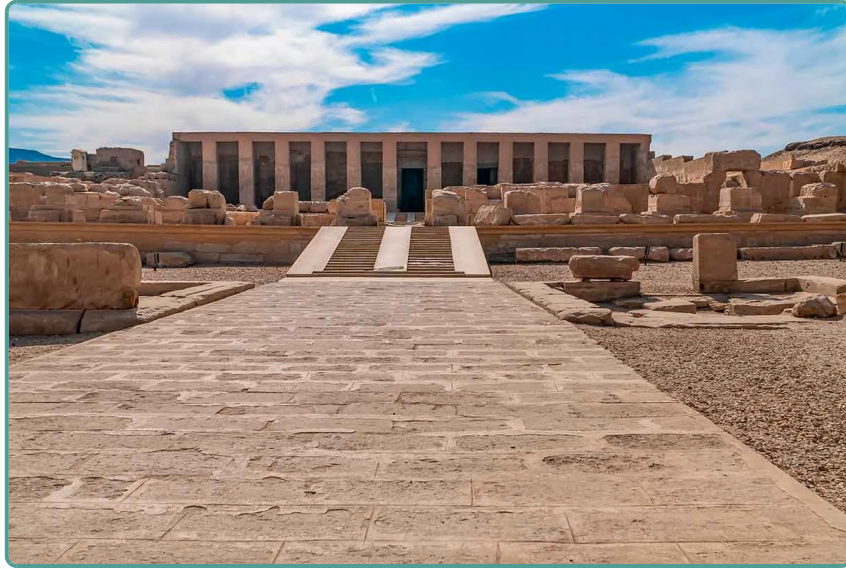
