ITINERARY

1 Cairo

Welcome to the land of Pharaohs with <u>Golavita Travel Egypt</u>, once you arrive at Cairo International Airport, our representative will help you with the arrival procedures then take you in a private car to your hotel to have smooth check-in.

Dinner Cruise: On the agreed time, your guide will join you from your hotel to Enjoy two hours dinner cruise in one of the luxury Nile Cruises boats. Enjoy your dinner with live music and belly dancer show and Tanoura show. Also, you can enjoy Cairo by night from the sundeck while sailing.

2 Cairo

Join your Egyptologist guide to a full day guide tour to Giza attractions. Explore with your guide the top of Egypt attractions, <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. Learn about ancient Egyptian history during the fourth dynasty, Old Kingdom. Discover the Great Pyramid of Cheops, <u>the Pyramid of Khafre</u> and the smallest Pyramid in Giza Plateau of Menkaure. Meanwhile, you can see the tombs of the Pyramid builders and watch the daily life on the walls on these tombs such as agriculture in ancient Egypt. <u>The Great Sphinx</u> in Giza plateau is the most famous one in Egypt with human head and lion body show the king as very smart and very powerful. Later on, you will go to enjoy your lunch meal, enjoy a typical Egyptian food in a local restaurant with the famous tahini salads, baba ghanouj and green salads. There is always chance for vegetarian meals. At the end of your tour, you will go back to your hotel for overnight.

3 Cairo - Luxor

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel before your join our representative to Cairo airport to fly to Luxor. Upon arrival, your guide will join you to <u>Luxor attractions</u> on Luxor east bank. Start with Luxor temple, it is the twin temple of Karnak temple and was connected to <u>Karnak temple</u> for the yearly festival called Opet Festival. Learn about Luxor Cache and what they found inside it in 1989, February 9th. Indeed, Alexander Chapel, Divine Birth room, the Luxor open air Museum worth a visit. Later on, you will go to check-in at your Nile Cruise for the next 7 nights. Enjoy your lunch on board and free time at your own leisure.

4 Luxor Attractions

Enjoy your morning coffee and hearty breakfast on board the Nile Cruise before you start your <u>Luxor day tours</u> to Luxor attractions on west bank with the Valley of the Kings, Kings Valley in Luxor dates back to the New Kingdom on ancient Egyptian history and on the top of Luxor attractions. Indeed, the Valley of the Kings houses more than 60 tombs for the Pharaohs of Egypt especially <u>Tutankhamun tomb</u>. Then go on a visit to <u>Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut</u>, Queen Hatshepsut ruled Egypt 20 years by her own and 3 years like co-ruler with her nephew Thutmose III. In fact, her engineer Senmut built her the temple in Deir El Bahari near the Mortuary temple of Mentuhotep II. Later on explore <u>the Memnon</u> <u>Colossi</u>, another Luxor attractions once standing in front of the biggest Mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on Luxor west bank. After that back to the Nile cruise for lunch and sail for the rest of the day towards Edfu city via Esna Lock.

5 Edfu - Kom Ombo

Early departure to Horus temple with horse carriages before breakfast to explore one of the most beautiful temples in <u>Egypt day tours</u>. Edfu temple known as Horus temple is one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt beside Dendera temple. Horus temple is a great source of the Egyptian Mythology, ancient Egyptian festivals especially the marriage between Horus and Hathor. After coming back to your Cruise boat, you will enjoy the breakfast at sail towards Kom Ombo city to visit the double temple of Sobek and Horus. Kom Ombo temple, it takes around 3 hours sailing while you enjoy the view from the sun deck till you reach Kom Ombo temple. Few minuets walking to you reach the temple. Back to the Nile cruise and sail to Aswan for overnight.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner

6 Nile Cruise (Temple of Ramesses)

Early departure to <u>Abu Simbel temple</u> with breakfast boxes at the reception. It takes 3 hours driving with a coffee break on the way to enjoy your breakfast and use the toilets if you like. Upon arrival, you will enjoy two hours marveling at the exceptional two cut temples of Abu Simbel for Ramesses the Great and his wife Nefertari. Learn how the twin temples of Abu Simbel were dismantled and relocated after the construction of <u>the Aswan High Dam</u>. Abu Simbel temples are rich with historical events like Kadesh Battel between Ramesses the great and the Hittites, his wars against Libyans. After that you will visit The Small temple of Hathor (The Nefertari temple) is on the western bank of Lake Nasser and 100 m to the north of the Great temple of Ramesses. At the end of your <u>Aswan day tours</u>, you will go back to your Nile Cruise for lunch and free time with the chance to sail with your guide to colored Nubian Village to know more about Nubian history.

7 Nile Cruise (Aswan Attractions)

Breakfast on board then start your Aswan day tours to <u>Aswan attractions</u> with The High Dam was built after the Low Dam (Khazan) was built and raised two times but was not good enough to control the annual flooding. Enjoy your visit to one of the biggest dams in the world and watch the created Lake Nasser. You will explore The unfinished Obelisk which is located in Aswan granite quarries from where they cut Hatshepsut Obelisk in Karnak. Then you will enjoy a short ride with a motorboat to <u>Philae temple</u> on Agilkia Island Aswan. Philae temple is one of the temples were relocated to a new location after the building of the High Dam. Then your guide will join you back to the Nile Cruise for lunch and free time till 14.00pm sailing time towards Luxor.

8 Nile Cruise (Luxor)

Free day at your own leisure on board the boat while sailing towards Luxor via Esna Lock.

9 Nile Cruise - Karnak Temple

Enjoy your last breakfast on board before you check out and start your visit to the biggest Cult temple in Egypt, <u>the Karnak temple</u>, Karnak is one of the best Cult temples you can visit in whole Egypt together with <u>Luxor temple</u>. At the end of your visit, you will head to Hurghada with your guide to check-in at your Hurghada hotel foe the next few days.

9 Disembarkation - Hurghada

Departure to Hurghada after breakfast to enjoy your next few days at the Red Sea resort.

11 Hurghada

Also, you are few steps far from El Moez street where you can admire every single inch there. Later on, you will go back to your hotel.


