OVERVIEW

Day 1 Hurghada tour to Cairo

A Golavita Travel Egypt representative will meet you at the reception of your hotel at 2:00 am to start your way to Cairo from your <u>Hurghada day tours</u>. Enjoy a short stop around 06.00 am to use the toilet (10 L.E. per person), enjoy your breakfast, or have your morning coffee.

Later, you will continue your way to Cairo. Start your <u>Cairo attractions</u> with one of the old seven wonders, <u>the Pyramids of Giza</u>. They are the top tourist attractions in Egypt and Hurghada Beach Vacation won't be complete without

them. Hemiunu built the Great Pyramid for the Pharoah Cheops to be his eternal place. The second biggest in the Giza Plateau is the Pyramids of Khafre. Explore The Great Sphinx and the Valley temple

Lunch: Enjoy your freshly cooked lunch at a local restaurant near the Pyramids area

The Grand Egyptian Museum is the world's largest museum dedicated to ancient Egyptian artifacts. Here you can see the Egyptian artifacts from the Old Kingdom, Middle Kingdom, and New Kingdom. At the end of the tour, your guide will drive you to the Giza Railway to board your sleeper train to Luxor.

Day 2 Cairo Attractions

Enjoy your delicious breakfast at the hotel, then start your full-day Cairo tour to the multi-religious compound, Old Cairo. In one street less than two kilometers away, you can see the three religious attractions near each other. You will start with the Hanging Church, which is near the Coptic Museum and the Roman Babylon Fortress. The Hanging Church was the first built in the basilica style.

Then visit Abu Serga Church. It is one of the oldest Coptic churches in Egypt, with unique Coptic church architecture. In your Hurghada holiday package, discover Ben Ezra Synagogue; it is one of the oldest Jewish synagogues in Cairo, located near the Church of Saint Sergius and Bacchus and behind the Coptic Museum.

Lunch: Lunch at a local restaurant in Cairo

After your lunch, you will visit the Citadel of Saladin. It is a magnificent structure that hosts medieval and 19th-century history. It has 4 gates, 13 towers, 4 mosques, and 2 museums, including the National Police Museum and the

National Military Museum. One of them is <u>the Muhammad Ali Mosque</u>, a very famous Cairo attraction near the City of Dead and Al Azhar Park.

In need, if you go outside the mosque, you will have an amazing view of Cairo from the highest point and the perfect chance to shoot photos for <u>Sultan Hassan Mosque</u> and Al Rifae Mosque. Also, you will see Ahmed Ibn Tulun Mosque and the Pyramids in the clear days. At the end of your Cairo tour, you will be driven back to your hotel in Hurghada.
