OVERVIEW

In fact with Luxury Egypt tours, Luxor will discover Tutankhamun tomb in the Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut temple and Amenhotep III Mortuary temple decorated with Memnon Colossi. Meanwhile, Luxor temple and Karnak temple. Finally, you will end your tour by the Red Sea resort in Marsa Alam where you can explore the Marine Life of the Red Sea, Red Sea coral reefs and colored fish.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Cairo

At the Cairo airport, a Golavita Travel Egypt representative will meet you and help you with the immigration and customs procedures. Once you are ready, your guide will join you in our modern new brand vehicle to your hotel in Cairo to check-in.

There are no meals.

Day 2 Giza Attractions

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, then start your full-day guided tour of Giza attractions. Start with <u>Giza Pyramids Complex</u>. Then, you will visit <u>Great Sphinx</u>. You will pass the Valley Temple on your way to the Sphinx, where the mummification—or at the very least, the Opening of the Mouth—is performed.

Lunch: Enjoy a freshly cooked lunch at a local restaurant before you proceed with your trip to the next stop

After lunch, you will enjoy discovering the Grand Egyptian Museum. You can view all 5793 of Tutankhamun's treasures in one location at the GEM, even if you have only ever seen them on television or in a documentary. When you finish your tour, you will go back to your hotel for overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 3 Alexandria

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel then start your <u>Alexandria day tours</u>. Once, you reach the pearl of the Mediterranean, you will start with the Pompey Pillar. then you will go to <u>the Catacomb of Kom El Shoqafa</u>. The catacomb was discovered by a donkey in September 28, 1900. Also, it is the largest Roman cemetery cut into the rock at a depth of 35m. There is a guided tour to <u>Alexandria Library</u> every two hours, so your guide will choose the right time to visit it. Your visit won't be completed without visiting the Citadel of Qaitbay dates to the 15th century. Thus, Al-Ashraf Qaitbay from Burji Mamluk state and sultan Qansoh El Ghoury gave much care to the fort.

Lunch: Enjoy your lunch in a local restaurant in Alexandria and try the tasty fish or choose your favorite dishes.

Day 4 Aswan attractions

Check out early in the morning and head to the Cairo airport for your flight to

Aswan. Upon arrival, your guide will join you to visit Aswan attractions such as

the Aswan High Dam. The High Dam created Lake Nasser and provided Egypt

with water for irrigation and electricity. Also, you can enjoy the Russian-Egyptian

friendship monument not far from the High Dam.

There are a lot of things to do in Aswan but overall, the top Aswan attraction,

Philae temple. After the Aswan High Dam was built, many temples were

relocated, including this one. You will be taken to your Nile Cruise for lunch and

the following three nights' lodging at the conclusion of the tour.

Day 5 Aswan - Kom Ombo

After breakfast aboard, you have a free morning in Aswan with the option to visit

the Abu Simbel Temple (at an additional cost) or the Nubian Village (at an

additional cost) to gain knowledge of Nubian customs and history. Around 14:00,

the Nile Cruise will set sail for Kom Ombo City.

Upon arrival, you will walk along the Nile River till you reach Kom Ombo temple

on the east bank of the Nile. Kom Ombo temple is unique from another point:

the surgical instruments here for the first time, the medicine in ancient Egypt.

Day 6 Edfu - Luxor

Early departure for a horse-drawn tour of Edfu City's Horus Temple. <u>Edfu Temple</u> is the best-preserved temple in Egypt and the source of information about the struggle between Horus and Seth and the construction of the temple process.

Meanwhile, in ancient Egypt, the Osiris leg myth and goddess Nut. You will return to the Nile cruise for breakfast after the visit, and then spend the rest of the day sailing through Esna Lock to Luxor.

Day 7 Disembarkation - Luxor

Enjoy your last breakfast on boar your Nile Cruise before you checkout to start your Luxor day tours to Luxor attractions. Start with Luxor temple.

Because of the avenue of sphinxes in front of it, the six colossi of Ramesses, and his obelisk, the temple of Luxor is well-known. Discover the additions made by Alexander the Great to the temple of Luxor and the well-known Divine Birth of Amenhotep.

When you reach <u>Karnak temple</u> walking the Sphinx Avenue or by car, you will be surprised how big it is. Karnak is the world's largest temple and the best example of ancient Egyptian architecture and sculpture. There is a lot to see at Karnak Temple, for example:

- Mut temple
- Khonsu temple
- The Red Chapel of Hatshepsut
- White Chapel of Pharaoh Senusret I
- The Hypostyle Hall

Day 8 Luxor West Bank - Marsa Alam

Breakfast on board the Nile cruise, then start your Luxor attractions in a tour to

the west bank with Valley of the Kings, visit 3 tombs and watch the religious

books decorating the walls of the tombs such as the Book of the Dead and the

Book of the Heavenly Cow.

Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut in Deir El Bahari is on the top of Luxor tourist

attractions as it is unique in designs and scenes. Hatshepsut, the female

Pharaoh, dedicated this temple to her heavenly father Amun and the yearly

festival known as the Valley Festivals. After that, you will visit Memnon Colossi.

Following your tour, we will transport you to Marsa Alam, where you will spend

the following four days.

Day 9 Marsa Alam

Enjoy a free day at the hotel to do as you please.
