OVERVIEW

It begins with an argument in Cairo, fighting through wretched traffic to see the world's last ancient wonder: the Pyramids of Giza. After touring Cairo, one boarded a sleeper train going southward, spending the night on the train while chugging along part of the desert. Through Egypt tours, you will spend several days in Luxor, Aswan and Abu Simbel to explore ancient ruins and temples. Then back to Cairo to explore vital Islamic and Christian historical sites. The Egypt tour package offers you the best classic trips that give you the opportunity to explore Egypt and learn about its history through 8 days spent in Egypt.

ITINERARY

1 Arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, you will be greeted by a Golavita Tour Guide, who will assist you with all the arrival procedures. Then, you will transfer to the hotel via a very nice air-conditioned vehicle, you will be checked in by the tour Guide, who will give you an overview of your vacation schedule so that you know what time you must be ready for each tour.

2 Journey Through History: Pyramids Tour and Train to Luxor Adventure

After having your breakfast and checking out from the hotel, you will be met by the tour guide to proceed to the Giza Plateau to see one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world: the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chefren, the famous Sphinx; and Valley Temple. After that, you will be taken to the Egyptian Museum to view the ancient great Egyptian artifacts and treasures. If time allows, you will also visit [Khan El Khalili](#), Cairo's oldest bazaar, known for its traditional souks.

Finally, you will be transferred to Giza railway station to board the sleeper train in a very picturesque atmosphere for your journey to [Luxor](#). You will get dinner on the train.

You will spend the night in your compartment on the train.

Food: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

3 Luxor Attractions

Upon arrival at the Luxor train station, a representative from Golavita Travel will be there to meet and assist you before you embark on your Luxor excursion.

Prepare to explore some of the most fascinating tombs on the West Bank of the Nile River in the [Valley of the Kings](#), visit the Temple of Hatshepsut, the female pharaoh who had a significant impact on Egypt's history, and see the impressive Colossi of Memnon. Afterward, you will have the opportunity to visit the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), known as one of the world's most extraordinary open-air museums and the second most-visited historical site in Egypt. Then, continue on to the grand [Karnak Temple complex](#) before returning to your hotel.

Stay overnight in Luxor.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

4 From Luxor to Aswan

Following breakfast, you will commence your journey to Aswan in a luxurious air-conditioned vehicle equipped with wifi. The travel time is estimated to be around three and a half hours. Upon arrival, a representative from Golavita Travel will welcome you and assist you with the check-in process at your hotel. Your schedule involves a trip to the [Unfinished Obelisk](#) in the granite quarries, followed by a guided tour of the well-maintained [Temple of Philae](#) on Isis Island, dedicated to the goddesses Isis and Hathor. Subsequently, you will return to your hotel for the evening.

Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.

5 Abu Simbel Tour

Start your group tour to the temples of Abu Simbel, which are approximately 3.5 hours away by car. you will be greeted by the extraordinary temples constructed for Ramses II and his beloved queen Nefertari. These temples, located near the Sudanese border, are renowned for their beauty and also for their intriguing modern history, they were entirely relocated in 1968 to prevent submersion by the vast Lake Nasser. Following your exploration of the temples, you will return to Aswan and embark on the sleeper train for an overnight journey back to Cairo.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner.

6 Return to Cairo

Treat yourself to a savory breakfast on board while traveling to Giza Train Station. Upon arrival, you will be met by our friendly local representative from Golavita Travel, who will help you check in to your hotel in Cairo. You may spend your time at leisure or go on an optional excursion to the [Step Pyramid of King Zoser](#) in Sakkara and Memphis.

Overnight in Cairo.

Meals: Breakfast.

7 Free Day with optional Alexandria Trip

Spend a complimentary day in Cairo, or opt for a journey to the dazzling coastal town of [Alexandria](#) in the north. There, you can explore the grand Qaitbay Fort, constructed by a formidable sultan in the 15th century on the grounds of Alexandria's ancient lighthouse, and then proceed to the esteemed [Library of Alexandria](#). Additionally, you will have the opportunity to tour the [Catacombs](#), an underground Roman burial site carved into the rock. Return to Cairo in the evening.

Accommodation in Cairo.

8 Last Day & Final departure

You will receive breakfast at your hotel, followed by transportation to Cairo International Airport for your departure.
