ITINERARY

1 Marsa Alam Luxor

Start your 5 Days Nile Cruise from Marsa Alam with a transfer from your hotel to Luxor. Upon arrival to Luxor, you will start your Luxor attractions on the east side of the Nile.

Karnak temple

The biggest Pharaonic temple in Egypt on Luxor east bank and a great source for ancient Egyptian history during the New Kingdom. There are a lot to admire here such as Hatshepsut Obelisk, the Great Hypostyle Hall, and Festival Hall of Thutmose III. Also, the sacred Lake, the Big Scarab, Sekhmet Shrine, Mut temple and Khonsu temple.

Luxor temple

Another Luxor attractions and one of the best temples in Luxor together with Karnak temple. Luxor temple was built by Amenhotep III of the 18th Dynasty and Ramesses the Great, Tutankhamun, Alexander the Great added parts to the temple. In fact, Ramesses Colossi, Obelisks, and pylon are among the highlights of the temple. Moreover, the Divine Birth is one of the most important carvings you can see on the walls.

At the end of your tour, you will be taken to have smooth check-in at your Nile cruise then lunch on board and free time at your own leisure till next day.

2 Luxor Edfu

Enjoy your breakfast on board the Nile cruise before you will join your guide to explore Luxor west bank.

Valley of the Kings

Kings Valley in Luxor is a must-see while you are in Luxor with its 62 tombs carved inside the mountain including Tutankhamun tomb. Amazing scenes from the book of dead, book of the day, night and book of the imyduat decorating the walls. Actually, the Valley is a great source for ancient Egyptian religion and funerary believes.

Hatshepsut temple

The Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut is a very unique temple on Luxor west bank for the only female Pharaoh ruled Egypt for about 23 years. Admire Hathor chapel, Anubis Chapel, Punt Expedition and the Divine birth of Hatshepsut on

the walls.

Memnon Colossi

Two massive statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III seated on the throne were decorating the entrance of the biggest Valley temple in Luxor. The temple was used for Opening of the Mouth rituals or Mummification purposes back then.

At the end of your Luxor top attractions on the west bank, you will go back to the Nile cruise for lunch and sail all day to Edfu city and overnight.

3 Edfu Kom Ombo Aswan

Enjoy your morning coffee at the cruise bar before you enjoy a short horse carriage ride to Edfu temple.

Horus temple

Edfu temple is the best-preserved temple dates back to the Ptolemaic era started under Ptolemy III Euergetes, and ended by Ptolemy XII Auletes. The temple is the only one has the legend of Horus and Seth in details. In fact, the temple was connected with Dendera temple with a very famous festival called the good union between Horus and Hathor.

Kom Ombo temple

The temple is in ruins but still have unique carvings like the Calendar, Surgical instruments, and the division of the temple by goddess Maat of justice and harmony.

After coming back to the cruise, the boat will sail to Aswan while dinner.

4 Abu Simbel

Early morning departure to Abu simbel temple in Nubia by Nasser Lake with breakfast boxes. Upon arrival, you will visit the two cut-rock temples of Abu Simbel.

Back to the Nile cruise in Aswan for lunch then start your Aswan attractions.

Aswan High Dam

Aswan High Dam is one of the world's largest embankment dams started in 1960 and ends 1970. It is one of Aswan attractions and it protects Egypt from the drought and enable the production of electricity power.

Philae temple

Isis temple or Philae temple on Agilkia Island was very famous as a healing center in the past and a place of pilgrimage for Egyptians and Nubians a like.

The temple is famous for the Obelisks standing now in the garden of Dorset

helped in the Decipherment of ancient Egyptian hieroglyphs. Ptolemy II

Philadelphus built the Holy of Holies and his followers Ptolemy III, Ptolemy V,

Ptolemy VI till Ptolemy XII decorated the temple.

Back to the cruise for dinner and overnight.
