ITINERARY

1 Arrival in Hurghada

2 Visit Dendera Temple & Nile Cruise to Luxor

After breakfast, leave the hotel by Hurghada and travel to Luxor, the ancient city. Along the way, stop by the Dendera Temple, Egypt's best-preserved temple complex devoted to the goddess Hathor.

There are several spectacular carvings, murals, and reliefs showcasing the ancient Egyptian artistry within this temple, which should be followed by the next journey to Luxor, where you will board a luxurious Nile Cruise.

Have a delicious lunch on board, and prepare for an evening visit to the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#). The temple, illuminated at night, gives off an air of magic, creating an unforgettable experience.

3 Head to the West Bank

You will enjoy a delicious breakfast on board and then start a full-day tour on the West Bank of Luxor. First, visit the famous [Valley of the Kings](#), where great pharaohs are buried, including [Tutankhamun tomb](#), and explore the beautiful tombs, and learn about the history of the New Kingdom.

Then, explore the impressive [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), carved into the cliffs-a true marvel of Egypt's architecture. The [Colossi of Memnon](#) stood sentinel over this land from the earliest times. After these spectacular visits, return to your cruise ship and travel to Edfu, where you can enjoy the Nile views and relax onboard.

4 Temples of Edfu & Kom Ombo

Today begins with a visit to the beautifully preserved [Temple of Edfu](#), a Ptolemaic structure dedicated to the falcon-headed god. The detailed carvings and well-preserved walls make this temple one of Egypt's finest.

Afterward, sail to [Kom Ombo](#), where you'll explore the unique double temple dedicated to the gods Sobek (crocodile god) and Haroeris. The temple's symmetrical design and inscriptions on its walls tell stories about ancient Egyptian religious beliefs. After visiting, continue your Nile cruise to Aswan, enjoying the breathtaking scenery.

5 Aswan Sightseeing

After breakfast, explore the highlights of Aswan, starting with the [Aswan High Dam](#), a modern engineering marvel that transformed Egypt's economy.

Visit the [Philae Temple](#), relocated to Agilkia Island due to the rising waters of Lake Nasser. The temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis, showcases beautiful architecture and intricate carvings.

Discover aspects of Nubian life before embarking on your Nile cruise in the late afternoon, which will include dinner and an overnight stay.

Optional journey: Enjoy an [Elephantine Island](#) Felucca ride around the place for great views of the Nile.

6 Abu Simbel optional trip

You could spend the morning relaxing on board your Nile Cruise as you savor the languorous views down the silvery waters of the Nile and the desolate surrounding landscape of the desert.

In the afternoon, you can choose to visit [Abu Simbel](#), one of Egypt's most famous sites. The huge temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari with their splendid statues and refined carvings, which bear testimony to the grandeur of ancient Egyptian civilization.

In the evening, you will return to Aswan, where you can either explore the local markets or enjoy a quiet night onboard.

7 Visit Kom Ombo & Edfu

A day on the river consists of leisurely passing from one port to the next, Kom Ombo, then Edfu, while the river unfolds breathtaking scenery to the beholder. Kom Ombo is home to temples dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris.

According to Horus of Edfu, these two temples are important indicators of Egypt's Ptolemaic period. Kom Ombo Temple's dual sanctuaries and ambivalent, symmetrical design are what give it its fundamental charm. You can enjoy a view of Upper Egypt's stunning scenery while relaxing inside the boat.

8 Exploring Luxor

Arrive in Luxor and visit the massive [Karnak Temple complex](#). This place is arguably one of the largest religious sites in the world. Thousands of years old, the complex boasts tall columns, obelisks, and carvings that endure as legacies of ancient Egyptian religious practices.

Visitors who want to learn more about the fascinating world of tombs may want to consider visiting the Mortuary Temple of Ramesses III at Medinet Habu or even exploring the tombs in Deir El Medina. These give the general public far less insight into day-to-day life in the New Kingdom.

9 Back to Hurghada

A delicious breakfast is served on board to start the day. Then, you will get off from your Nile Cruise and go back to Hurghada, the city with its beautiful beaches facing the Red Sea. It will be a very picture-postcard drive from Luxor to Hurghada through the Egyptian countryside.
