


9 Days Cairo, Fayoum, Luxor and Aswan Package

With 9 Days Cairo, Fayoum, Luxor and Aswan Package you will enjoy Egypt Luxury tours and explore top Cairo Attractions like Giza Pyramids, The Great Pyramid of Khufu, Valley Temple Of Khafre, The Great Sphinx, Grand Egyptian Museum with Egypt tours.Don't miss Fayoum Attractions because your will see Wadi Al Hitan, Valley of the Whales, Fossil and Climate Change Museum, Mudawara Mountain, and Wadi Al Ryan Water Falls. Then Egypt travel packages will take you to discover Luxor Attractions such as Karnak Temple, Luxor Temple, Valley of the Kings, Colossi of Memnon and Hatshepsut Temple. After that you will see Aswan Attractions like Edfu temple, Kom Ombo temple and Philae temple.

ITINERARY

Day 1 Cairo

Golavita Travel Egypt representative will greet and assist you through immigration and customs formalities at Cairo airport. Once you are ready, your guide will join you in our modern new brand vehicle to your hotel in Cairo to check in. Afternoon, choose between a hours Nile Cruise dinner while sailing to see Cairo from the water or Dinner at a local restaurant then visit <u>Khan El Khalili</u> Bazaars

Meals: dinner

Day 2 Cairo - Pyramids Tour

Enjoy your hearty breakfast at the hotel, then your full day tour to some of the best <u>Cairo attractions</u>. You will start your Cairo day tour with your guide to <u>Giza</u>

<u>Pyramids Complex</u>. Start your Cairo tour with one of the Egypt wonders, Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian history during the Old Kingdom. Visit <u>the Great</u> <u>Sphinx</u>, end your tour by the huge statue of Khafre as a sphinx and why it was with human head and lion body. At the end of your tour, you will go for lunch.

Lunch: Enjoy a freshly cooked lunch at a local restaurant before you proceed your trip to the next stop

<u>The Grand Egyptian Museum</u> is the largest archaeological museums in the world and it will house around 100 000 Egyptian artifacts. You will discover the ancient Egyptian history from the Predynastic Period

Day 3 Cairo - Fayoum Oasis

Breakfast at the hotel then drive to <u>Fayoum Oasis</u> to start your day in the Wadi El Ryan, designated as Protected Area in 1989 in the western desert. Your Fayoum tour includes Wadi Al Hitan, Valley of the Whales Fossil and Climate Change Museum, Mudawara Mountain, Wadi Al Ryan Water Falls. At the end of your day trip to Fayoum from Cairo, you will go back to your hotel again for overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 4 Cairo - Luxor

After breakfast, we will drive you to Cairo airport to catch your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, you guide will start you're your <u>Luxor attractions</u> with Luxor temple. Enjoy the six massive statutes of Ramesses the great, The twin Obelisk of the Concorde, Tutankhamun Opet festival scenes, Alexander the great chapel, the Avenue of the Sphinxes. Later on, you will visit <u>Karnak temple</u> where you will see Hieroglyphics writings, Ritual scenes, Shrines, Pylons, and Obelisks. You will visit Sekhmet shrine in Ptah temple, the temple of Ramesses III, Thutmoses Obelisk, and his daughter Hatshepsut. Then, your guide will join you to check-in your Nile Cruise and lunch on board.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 5 Luxor - Esna - Edfu

Enjoy your scrumptious breakfast on board then start your Luxor attractions on the west bank of the Nile. You will start with the easiest stop, <u>Memnon Colossi</u>. After you finish your stop by the massive statues of Memnon, you will drive to the Valley of the Kings. Once you pass the visitor center and take the electric car to the entrance of the King's valley, you will have your ticket with you and your guide will explain you the history of Egypt during the 18th, 19th, 20 dynasties. Why the Egyptian Pharaohs chose that place? Who dug the tomb? What about tombs decorations? Tombs funerary objects? And so on. He will recommend 3 tombs for you but Tutankhamun tomb is extra charge with two more.

After the Valley of the Kings, you will visit <u>the Mortuary temple of Hatshepsut</u> in El Deir El Bahari de3dicated to God Amun. Enjoy some free time then back to the Nile Cruise for lunch and sail to Edfu city via Esna Lock and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 6 Edfu - Kom Ombo - Aswan

Early visit to Horus temple in Edfu city with horse carriages to enjoy the bestpreserved Egyptian temple. <u>Edfu temple</u> is one of the great sources for the Egyptian history during the Greco Roman era. Watch the struggle between Horus and Seth, and Myth of the leg of Osiris. After the visit, you will go back to the cruise and breakfast then sail to Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 7 Aswan

Early morning departure with breakfast boxes to <u>Abu Simbel</u> about 4 hours driving. Enjoy the huge temple of Ramesses the great and his wife Queen Nefertari. Also, you will visit Hathor temple where Nefertari is portrayed like Hathor and the beautiful offering scenes in front of many gods and goddess or ancient Egypt. Marvel two hours to the amazing temples before you head back to Aswan.

Nubian Village, After lunch on bard, you can enjoy free afternoon or you can join your guide to the Nubian village where you will be face to face with Nubians. Enjoy their colorful houses, traditions, history, make Henna Tattoos if you like before you sail back to your cruise.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 8 Aswan - Cairo

Start your <u>Aswan attractions</u> with one of the largest dams in the world, Aswan High Dam. Listen to your guide and figure out what <u>the High Dam</u> did to Egypt and how it helped Egypt's development. Enjoy a short ride with a motorboat to Philae temple in Aswan on Agilkia island. Isis temple is one of the most beautiful Pharaonic temples in Egypt. The temple was dedicated mainly to goddess Isis, Hathor, Osiris and Horus. Later, we will drive you to Aswan airport to catch your flight to Cairo. Then, again we will transfer you from Cairo airport to your hotel in Cairo.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 9 final departure

Breakfast at the hotel then check out and transfer to Cairo airport for the final departure.
